

CONDUCT IN THE LIBRARY

The following rules will apply to all persons wishing to use the Pittsburg-Camp County Public Library:

1. Smoking is prohibited in all public areas of the library, including the meeting rooms, foyer, and restrooms.
2. There will be no food or drink permitted in the library, unless provided for a special activity and approved in advance by the Library Director.
3. The consumption of alcoholic beverages on the premises or the use of the library by those under the influence of alcohol or drugs is prohibited.
4. Sleeping in the library is prohibited.
5. Restrooms are provided for the convenience of patrons. They are not to be used for routine hygiene. **No items should be taken inside restrooms. You may leave items at front desk.**
6. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated in the library. Actions that disturb other patrons will not be tolerated.
7. Abusive actions toward staff or other patrons, whether verbal or physical, will not be permitted.

Violation of these rules of conduct may result in expulsion from the library. If necessary, the police will be notified.
