

MINORS IN THE LIBRARY

While the Public Library wishes to serve the children, it feels the following rules must apply for the safety of all:

1. Children under the age of twelve (12) will not be left unattended in the library. Children under the age of twelve (12) may not visit the library without a parent, guardian, or adult supervisor over the age of eighteen (18) present.
2. All children under the age of eighteen must be picked up from the library by a parent or guardian prior to closing. If after fifteen (15) minutes, they are still in the library, police will be notified.
3. Parents or guardians will be responsible for the behavior of minors when in the library. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated in the library. Actions that disturb other patrons will not be tolerated. If they fail to exercise such control, minors will be asked to leave the library and/or police may be notified.
4. Parents or guardians will be responsible for items that children or any minor listed on their card check out. This is not the responsibility of the Library staff.
